The Mobile Health Clinic provides LCPS students who are enrolling in school with:

- Physicals
- Wellness checks
- Referrals to community healthcare partners

In partnership with Inova and The George Washington School of Nursing, Loudoun County Public Schools launched the Mobile Health Clinic in June 2023 to support LCPS families by providing free physicals and wellness checks for students enrolling in LCPS.

The Mobile Health Clinic is also supported by a Virginia Department of Education Community Schools Development and Implementation grant. LCPS has six Community Schools: Forest Grove, Guilford, Rolling Ridge, Sugarland, Sully and Sterling elementary schools. During the summer of 2023, the Mobile Health Clinic will visit these schools to offer services.

The Mobile Health Clinic can not provide sports physicals.
